### **INFORMATION AND ACTION ITEMS:**

The CAO presented the draft 2024 municipal budget and highlighted the following:

- Tonight's budget, as presented, reflects a 5.2% increase for residential ratepayers and 3.7% for commercial ratepayers
- The CAO then proceeded to review the estimates line by line with Council beginning with revenues and then expenditures
- Fire Dept increase volunteer points as they are now meeting weekly rather than biweekly
- Received 2 \$5,000 payments from the WSIB excellence program \$5,000 left in operating to offset Safety Hub subscription and 2024 Health & Safety training. The other \$5,000 to be transferred to reserves Succession Planning
- No extra funds for Integrity Commissioner investigations
- No allowance for Detachment Board still an unknown
- The CAO advised Council that it was decided to not purchase the second hand grader, as it appears that the rear diff may be gone.
- Should we increase winter sand ask PW Super
- Will need to include energy costs for new streetlights next year
- Discuss garbage contract and commercial bins at an upcoming meeting
- A duckweed problem has been identified at the lagoon
- Sewer surplus very low need to increase rates to cover future costs/emergencies the CAO presented a scenario showing a \$2.00/month increase
- Provide Council with a \$3.00/month increase in sewer rates and \$1.00/month for water rates
- The CAO will speak to OCWA about accepting domestic waste from the surrounding areas SRFN and Township of the North Shore to increase our sewer revenues
- There is nothing in the budget to transfer funds to fire reserves
- The CAO will adjust the budget to include a transfer to fire reserves and keep the budget increase around 6.5%
